IGNATIANA

“We decided to come together for some days before separating, to discuss with one another our vocation and manner of life. After doing this for several days, we were divided by different ideas and opinions concerning our state of life. There was unity of mind and purpose: to seek the gracious and perfect will of God according to the scope of our vocation; but there were various opinions concerning the more effective and more successful means, both for ourselves and for our fellowmen. (...) Finally, we decided affirmatively, namely, that since the most kind and loving Lord had deigned to unite us to one another and to bring us together - weak men and from such different places and cultures - we should not sever God's union and his bringing us together, but rather everyday we should strengthen and more solidly ground it, forming ourselves into one body”.

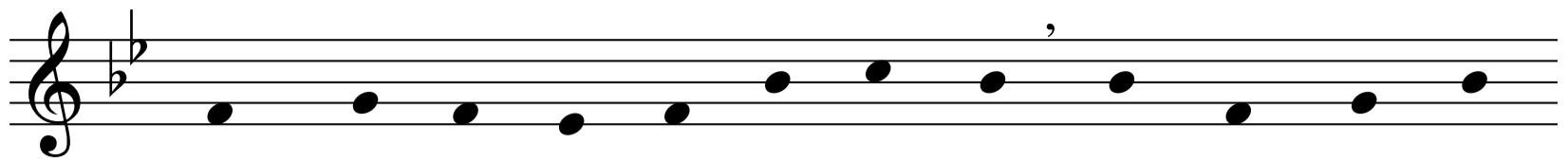

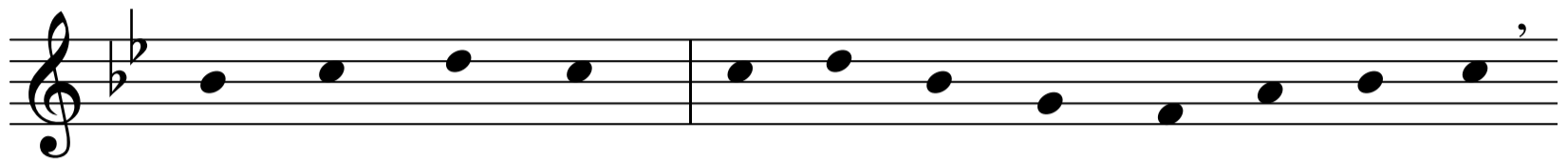

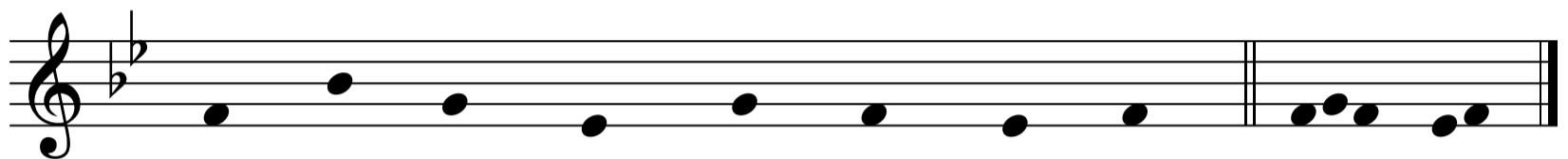
